The Croatian Research Information System (CroRIS) was developed as part of the Ministry of Science and Education's strategic project, "Scientific and Technological Foresight," co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund. The University of Zagreb University Computing Centre (Srce) partnered in the project. Ruder Bošković Institute (RBI) formally joined the project in 2021. CroRIS aims to provide comprehensive, complete and accurate data on Croatian research information.

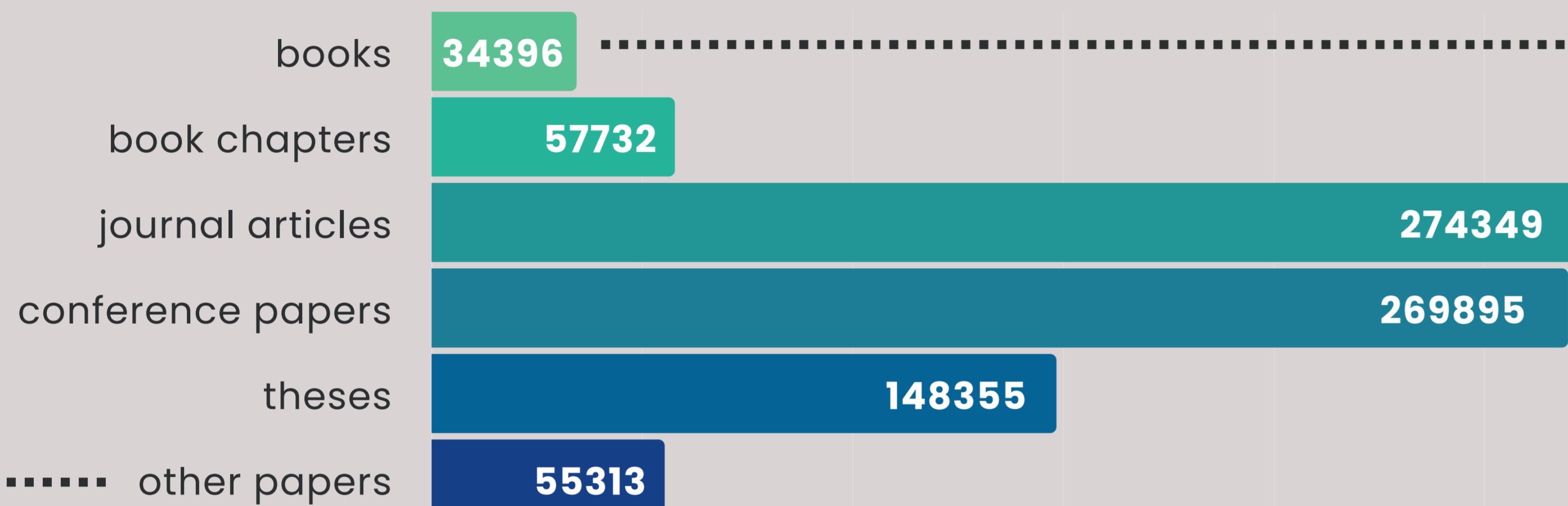

CROSB

Croatian scientific bibliography CROSB comprises bibliographic data on scientific and professional publications by researchers from the science and higher education system of the Republic of Croatia. First version of CROSB was created back in 1997, developed and maintained by the Centre for Scientific Information of Ruder Bošković Institute. In July 2023 CROSB was migrated and integrated into Croatian Research Information System CroRIS as one of the several modules. Publications are dispersed into different publication types: books, book chapters, journal articles, conference papers, theses, and other papers.

BOOKS

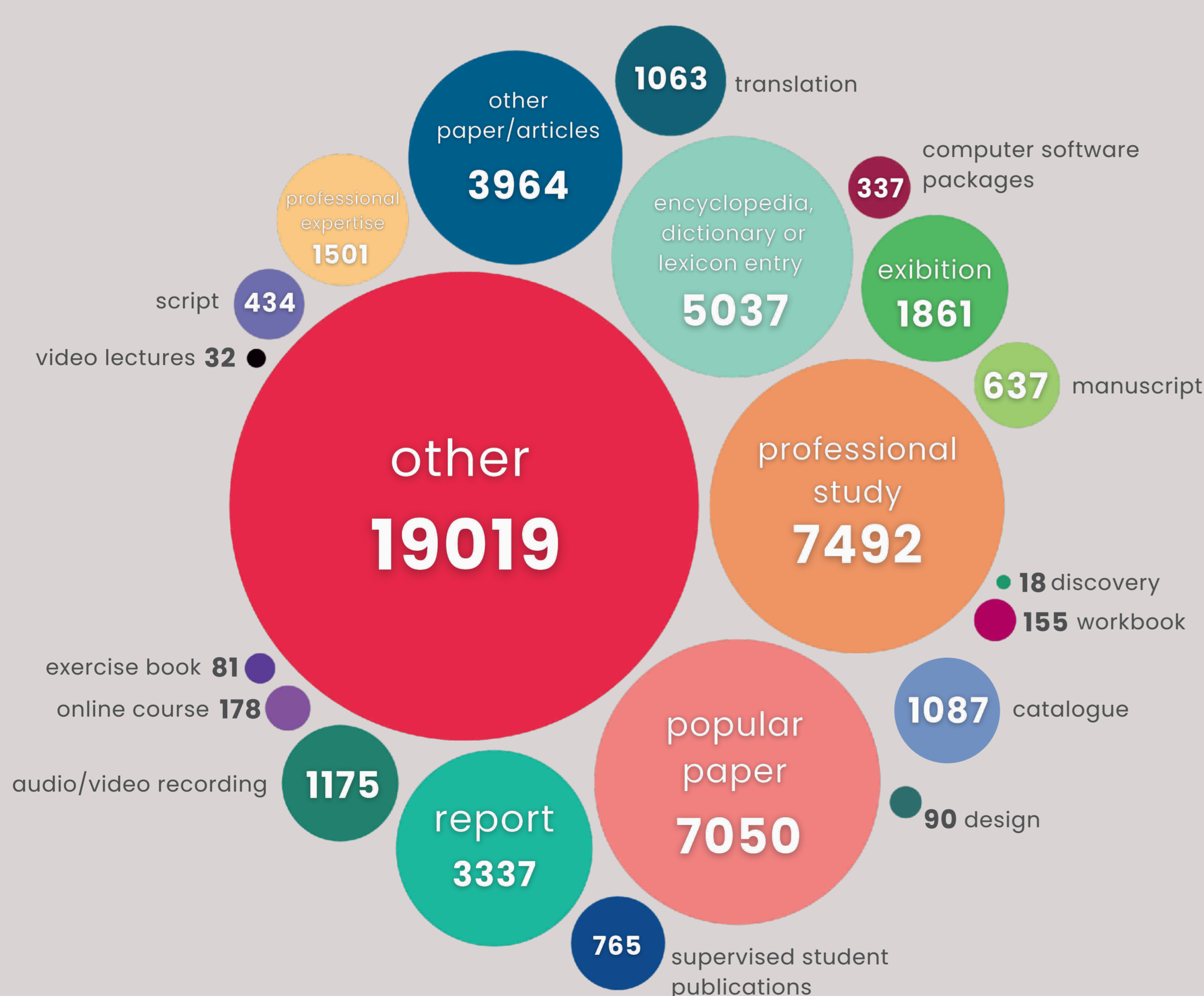


Journal articles and conference papers are the most common type of publications, followed by dissertations and theses. Books are divided into authored and edited, with conference proceedings being the most prevalent among edited books, followed by scientific monographs and abstract books.

The Other papers category includes a variety of publications, with the largest sub-group labeled other, consisting of records that do not fit into any other category (e.g., videos, unpublished works, costume designs). Other notable types include professional studies, popular papers, encyclopedia, dictionary or lexicon entry, reports, and other papers/articles.

CroRIS & OA

CroRIS module CROSB supports open science in several ways by linking to open access publications, providing information on article processing charges (APCs), and offering comprehensive access to publication metadata. Built on the CERIF data model, CroRIS ensures seamless interoperability with major research infrastructures such as EOSC and others. Ongoing efforts are focused on expanding interoperability, including integration with the DABAR system (Digital Academic Archives and Repositories), OpenAIRE, and the incorporation of metadata from Data Management Plans (DMPs).

CONCLUSION

While CROSB primarily provides information on peer-reviewed publications such as journal articles, books, and book chapters, it also includes a wide range of other publication types, many of which fall under grey literature. This makes CROSB a valuable and comprehensive resource for discovering literature that might otherwise remain difficult to find.
